CONCLUDE

Assuming H_0 true ($p_1 - p_2 = 0$), there is a 0.0136 probability of getting a $\hat{p}_1 - \hat{p}_2 = 0.197 - 0.385 = -0.188$ or lower purely by chance.

Because $0.0136 < 0.05$, we reject H_0 and we have convincing evidence that there has been an increase in the proportion of all kochia plants that are resistant to glyphosate.
