Officer During the past twenty years the tasks required of police officers have expanded and changed with dramatic rapidity. The traditional roles of the police had been those of law enforcement and the maintenance of public order. As a consequence police officers were typically large-bodied males, selected for their physical abilities and trained to accept orders and enforce the law. Over the past two decades, however, the industrialized nations have placed a variety of new demands on police officers. To traditional law enforcement and public order tasks have been added social work, mental health duties, and community relations work. For example, domestic disputes, violence between husbands and wives, lovers, relatives, etc., have increased in frequency and severity (or at least there has been a dramatic increase in reporting the occurrence of domestic violence).
