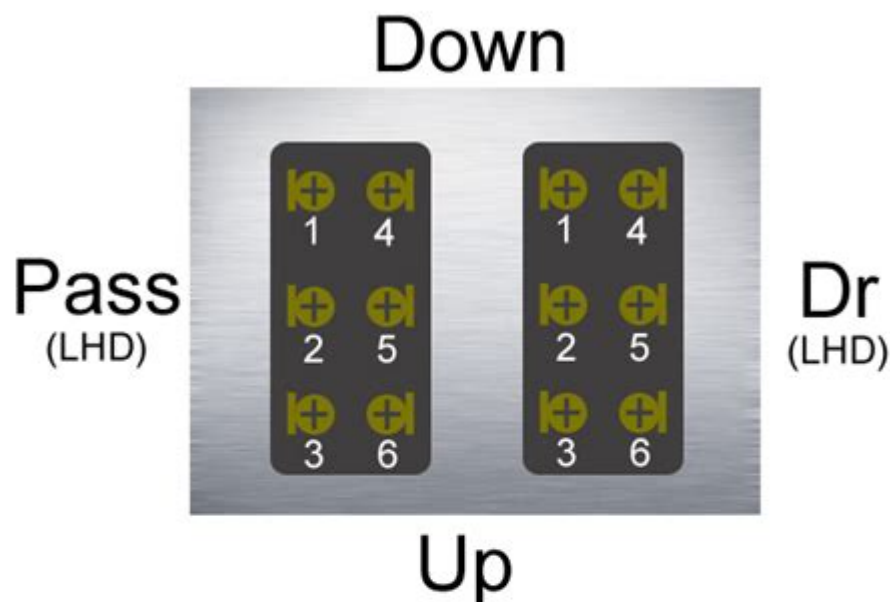


Ford Window Switch Wiring Diagram
