Lab 3: Axial Skeleton

Bone Structure:

Diaphysis (shaft)

- Medullary (marrow) cavity

Epiphysis (ends)

- Proximal & distal, mostly spongy

Periosteum

- Surrounds, isolates bone

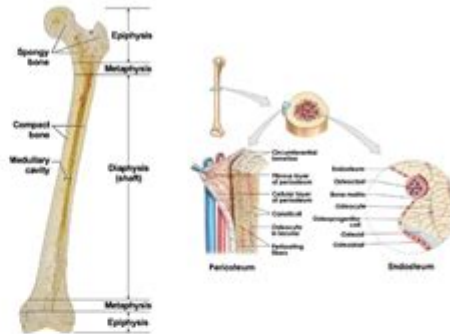
Endosteum

- Lines marrow cavity & central canal

Articular Cartilage

- Hyaline, very slick

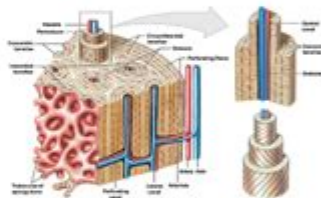
Marrow Cavity



Types of Bone Tissue

1. Compact Bone

- External surface of the bone
- Dense, few pores/ spaces
- Has osteons



2. Spongy Bone

- Many pores & spaces
- No osteons

Skeletal System

Axial Skeleton

- Skull
- Auditory ossicles & hyoid bone
- Vertebral column
- Thoracic cage

Hyoid Bone: supports tongue
("hanging" bone in back of skull)

Appendicular Skeleton

- Pectoral & pelvic girdles
- Upper & lower limbs
