The threat these officers pose became clear when

at least twenty-eight current and former law enforcement officials were alleged to have participated in the 2021 Capitol breach. With chapters on "The Rise of the Proud Boys," "A New Approach to Policing Hate Crimes," and "Policing the Police," Policing White Supremacy shows how the lack of transparency and accountability in federal, state, and local law enforcement has eroded public trust and undermined democracy.
